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DESCRIPTION OF TOUR

We chose three countries, three unique regions, where each of them presents a different culture, history and architecture. Those are:

- 1) Kashubia, Central and West Pomerania
- 2) Ystad i Osterlen
- 3) Lithuania and the Pałanga region

In each of these points, we selected the most interesting objects, which are located a short distance (no more than 40 km) from the main point where we suggest accommodation. The most convenient means of transport is a car, although you can reach every place using public transport. Some objects require several dozen minutes of hiking.

SCHEDULE & ACTIVITIES

Day 1 – LEBORK/POLAND

- After breakfast, we will visit the historic center of Lębork, city fortifications with special regard to the Sanctuary of St. Jacob. The trip will include: a walk within the medieval walls of the city, combined with a visit to the church and the possibility of entering the tower, where is a viewpoint. Then we will visit the restored towers and museum (guided tour or using Audioguids). Lunch on site.
- Travel on the Lębork - Wejherowo route (journey time 1 h) - visiting the Calvary of Wejherowo, the Franciscan monastery and the church of St. Anne.
- Then drive to Sianów (travel time, about 40 minutes) where there is a miraculous image of St. Mary, crowned Queen of Kashubia.
- From Sianów, the road leading through picturesque Kashubia, we will go to Koszalin. Dinner on the route or in the place of accommodation. (journey time about 2.5 hours).

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Day 2 - Central and West Pomerania

- After breakfast, let's start the day with a trip to the Holy Mountain of Pomorania – Chełmska Chill, where is the Sanctuary of the Virgin Mary, Thrice admirable.
- Then we will go to Kołobrzeg (journey time approx. 1 hour), where we will see a huge restored after the war St. Mary's Basilica, with rich furnishings. Lunch in Kołobrzeg.
- Then a trip to Trzebiatów (travel time about 1 hour) and visiting the ruins of the church in Trzęsacz (journey time 0.5 hours).
- The last point to visit on this day is Kamień Pomorski (journey time 0.5 h). Supper.
- The trip to Swinoujście Ferry to Ystad 22.30 - Unity Line. Overnight on the ferry.

Day 3 - Ystad

- 6.30 am coming to Ystad. Breakfast at Ystad. After breakfast, visit the St. Mary's Church and the church of St. Peter.
- From Ystad we will go to Ales Stenar (about 40 minutes). The tiny fishing village of Kaseberga is famous for the early medieval tomb of the commander, which forms 59 boulders set in the shape of a boat, on the high sea shore. Lunch on site.



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- After lunch, a trip to Kivik, where the Royal Burial Ground is located, with the largest Bronze Age tomb in Scandinavia. On the way, we will visit medieval churches in Loderup and Vitaby.
- From here we will go to Kristainstad for an overnight stay and dinner. On the way there is a magnificent Romanesque church in Norra Asum.

Day 4 - Karlsham

- After breakfast, we will go on a tour of Kristianstad, among others the church of St. Trinity, which is considered the most beautiful Renaissance church of northern Europe.
- From Kristianstad, we will go to Solvesborg to visit the Gothic church of St. Nicholas, and then we will go to Karlsham. Lunch.
- In the city of Karlsham we will spend time until about 18.00 and then we will go to the ferry to Klaipeda, which leaves at 19.00. Overnight on the ferry.

Day 5 - Klaipeda i Curonian Spit

- The ferry arrives to Klaipeda at 9.00. Breakfast on the ferry or in Klaipeda.
- After a short tour of the city, we will go to the Curonian Spit (the possibility of traveling by bus or car).
- In Judnokrante, we will go to the Mountain of Witches (Raganu Kalnas). On the way to Nida (about 50 km) we will go to the top of the Gray Dunes (about 2 hours). Nida is a well-known resort. Lunch on site. In the center, we will visit the churches and the astronomical clock designing the time and holidays during the year.
- Return to Klaipeda for dinner and overnight.

Day 6 - A trip over the Neman River

- After breakfast, we will go to Taurogi (travel time approx. 2 h). The city was an important center of Lutheranism - there you can see a rebuilt church from the midnineteenth century and a beautiful Neo-Roman Catholic church. Lunch on site.
- A trip along the Nemunas (between Jurbarkus and Seredzius) along the route of ancient settlements that witnessed the Crusades against Lithuania in the 13th and 14th centuries
- Our trip will slowly end here. **The only thing left to return to the place from which it all began.**
