DATES OF THE TRIPS:

1. Tailored Trip for a Group

Participants, led by a group coordinator, establish the dates which are tailored to the needs of participants.

The trip will take place as only a group of 16 people will be collected. The participants pay as for the group of 16 people, when more people attend they will receive a refund. This trip assures the highest level of adjusting the program to the group needs, but medium level of good wind conditions.

2. A Pre Set up Date Trip

The Company will assign several dates in the seasons when the wind conditions are supposed to be good. This type of the trip assures that it will take in the foreseen dates including surprise events. The trip will take place as only a group of 16 people will be collected.

The Price*

The price for 16 person group is 1550 € per person.

Some discounts will be available if the group will be bigger but maximum 20 persons.

Financing*

Many, especially young clients, may want to receive financing for your Dream Tour.

We will assure a loan in 12 monthly installments after paying 20% of initial contribution with 5% p.a.

It will mean in 16 person group size, that after paying 300 € initial contribution the remaining amount will be paid in 12 equal amounts of 125 €. Of course if the group will be bigger the sums will be lower.
